CLEARCALM 3 CLARIFYING CLAY CLEANSER £18, by *Ren*, from beautyexpert.co.uk. This everyday cleanser is a great long-term solution for combination skin. It has brilliant antibacterial properties, without being drying

ACNE TREATMENT £16.50, by *Malin+Goetz*, from spacenk.co.uk. An overnight treatment that contains a high dosage of active sulphur to provide quick relief. It takes the heat and redness out of a blemish, as well as helping to prevent scarring

CLEAR IMPROVEMENT MASK £17, by *Origins* (origins.co.uk). Slather on this thick black face mask once a week. The combination of activated charcoal and white china clay draws out impurities from under the skin, leaving it instantly clearer

PURE THERAPY FACIAL SERUM £31.70, by *Antonia Burrell*, from beautique.com. Apply this super-charged formula of 21 pure plant extracts under your moisturiser – or use alone if you have particularly oily skin. It helps regulate oil production

CONCEALING SPOT TREATMENT £22.50, by *Dermalogica*, from lookfantastic.net. This brand is known for its skin-clearing products, and its two-in-one treatment is our favourite. Zinc and salicylic acid zap spots, while the light coverage conceals redness

OUTER PEACE BLEMISH RELIEF PADS £20.50, by *Aveda* (aveda.co.uk). If you suffer from breakouts avoid heavy exfoliation, which can cause inflammation. Instead, try these gentle pads – they slough away dead skin and treat any existing pimples
